

Transportation to and from the South Jersey Healthcare Regional Medical Center

It is our goal to make your experience at the SJH Regional Medical Center as comfortable and convenient as possible, including your transportation to and from our hospital. For patients who cannot provide their own transportation, there are several safe and easily accessible options available.

New Jersey Transit Bus Service - New Jersey Transit's 553 bus stops on the RMC campus regularly on its route from Upper Deerfield to Atlantic City, and also makes various stops in Bridgeton, Vineland and Millville. A bus stop is located outside of the main entrance on the perimeter drive. Bus schedules are available at the information desks in the front lobby and the Emergency Department.
